Notifications

Dependency on PayGlobal version 4.72.0.0

This version of ESS is dependent on a PayGlobal version of at least 4.72.0.0. Do not upgrade to this release of ESS until PayGlobal has been upgraded to at least 4.72.0.0.

Dependency on .NET Framework 4.8 Runtime

If your server is below Windows Server 2022 you will need to install the .NET Framework 4.8 Runtime which you can download from Microsoft. Once the .NET Framework 4.8 Runtime is successfully installed, it is necessary to restart your server for the changes to take effect.

ESS support for MS Server 2022

ESS has been tested and can now be confirmed as being compatible with the MS Server 2022 Operating System.

New IRD number validation

The IRD has extended the valid range for IRD numbers.

PayGlobal ESS has been updated to support this change. IRD numbers in the range 10-000-000 to 200-000-000 (inclusive) are now accepted during validation.

Issues Resolved - All Countries

Timesheet Managers sometimes cannot Save / Approve Transaction Timesheets

Description

This issue can arise if a manager has no access to entity values present on a transaction timesheet submitted by an employee (a security query has prevented access), but time sheeting has been configured to use the employee's security profile within the ESS Admin site (*Lookup security profile mode* option).

In this case, a manager could not save or approve the employee timesheet.

Resolution

In the scenario mentioned above, managers can now save and approve timesheets submitted by an employee.
