## Enhancements – Australia

### *Study and training support loans (STSL) changes*

The Universities Accord (Cutting Student Debt by 20 per cent) Bill 2025 has now passed Parliament.

This will take effect for all pays processed with a **payment date** on or after **24<sup>th</sup> September 2025**.

The Bill resulted in the following changes:

- Minimum repayment threshold increasing to \$67,000 (was \$56,156 as of 1<sup>st</sup> July, \$54,435 in 2024-25)
- Compulsory repayments have moved to a marginal repayment system and are only calculated on the income above \$67,000 (instead of the total repayment income).

The formula for the calculation is now:  **$y = ax - b$**  (was  **$y = ax$** )

- **y** is the weekly study and training support loans component.
- **x** is the weekly earnings – or weekly equivalent of earnings – rounded down to whole dollars plus 99 cents.
- **a** and **b** are the values of the component rates as shown in the following tables.

PayGlobal has been updated as per the ATO's new **Schedule 8 - Statement of formulas for calculating study and training support loans components**.

**IMPORTANT:** The new tax tables will not be on the ATO's public site until around 24<sup>th</sup> Sept. The tables below are what the ATO have provided to software providers.

## Supported versions and environments.

Compatible environments continuously change based on the developments in manufacturers' environments that are outside the control of MYOB.

MYOB actively manages the compatibility of MYOB PayGlobal with various environments.

The following sections outline the supported versions of MYOB PayGlobal products and the minimum environments they need to run.

### Employee Self-Service (ESS)

The current minimum supported version is v5.6.0.0

*Important: If you are using an unsupported version, please contact your account manager so that we can help you upgrade to a more recent, supported version.*

### Minimum Supported Environments

The minimum operating systems PayGlobal required is:

- **Desktop Operating System** - Windows 10  
*Note: Support for Windows 8.1 ended in January 2023*
- **Server Operating System** - Windows Server 2016  
*Note: Support for Windows Server 2012 ended in October 2023*
- SQL Server 2016 (SP3).
- **.NET Framework** – It is recommended that latest version of .NET Framework run time is installed. (Minimum is 4.8)
- **Transport Layer Security (TLS)** - TLS 1.2 is recommended but PayGlobal will fall back if the Operating System doesn't enable TLS1.2.
