PayGlobal NHibernate Package Upgrade

This package has been upgraded to the latest stable version to remove known security vulnerabilities. This package is used by PayGlobal to communicate with the database by Process Pay, STP and Payday Filing primarily. This has also changed the bridge components in Self-Service (ESS) and will now require the Config Updater to be run whenever a new version of PayGlobal is installed (provided you are using ESS).

Issues Resolved - All Countries

Unnecessary Updates of Accumulating User Defined Fields During Pay Close

Details

When a pay was closed and there was an accumulating user defined field with a Leave period type configured, then unnecessary SQL update statements were made on the database for all employees who had values in the user defined field. The data values were correct, but there were potentially many update statements carried out for no reason.

Resolution

These unnecessary updates no longer occur.

Rebuild Actual Accumulators / Roster Accumulators Does Not Work

Details

When either the “Rebuild Roster Accumulators” or the “Rebuild Actual Accumulators” tree action was selected in PayGlobal, these accumulators were not updated.

Resolution

These two actions will now successfully rebuild accumulators.

Supported versions and environments.

Compatible environments continuously change based on the developments in manufacturers' environments that are outside the control of MYOB.

MYOB actively manages the compatibility of MYOB PayGlobal with various environments.

The following sections outline the supported versions of MYOB PayGlobal products and the minimum environments they need to run.

Employee Self-Service (ESS)

The current minimum supported version is v5.6.0.0.

You **MUST** run the Config updater following the installation of the v4.75.0.0 Bridge Components. This process controls the access to the libraries you require and ensure ESS continues to run.

Important: *If you are using an unsupported version, please contact your account manager so that we can help you upgrade to a more recent, supported version.*

Minimum Supported Environments

The minimum operating systems PayGlobal required is:

- **Desktop Operating System** - Windows 10
Note: Support for Windows 8.1 ended in January 2023
- **Server Operating System** - Windows Server 2016
Note: Support for Windows Server 2012 ended in October 2023
- SQL Server 2016 (SP3).
- **.NET Framework** – It is recommended that latest version of .NET Framework run time is installed. (Minimum is 4.8)
- **Transport Layer Security (TLS)** - TLS 1.2 is recommended but PayGlobal will fall back if the Operating System doesn't enable TLS1.2.
